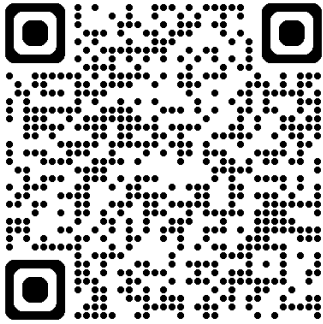

“Advance Care Planning: What I need to know”
