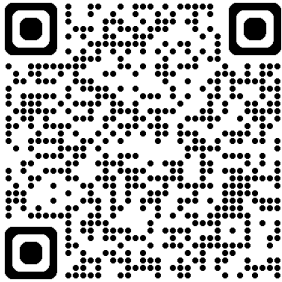

Advance Care Planning: What I Need to Know

Advance care planning is the process of preparing legal documents that allow you to name someone to speak for you and make your medical decisions, if you cannot speak for yourself. No matter what your age or circumstances, this course will help you complete legal documents to communicate your wishes to your loved ones and medical care providers.

Attend this course to:

- Learn about Texas Law and how to ensure your wishes are met.
- Discuss how to talk with your family, and those close to you, about your future healthcare choices.
- Prepare the legal documents to share with your family and your health care team.
